The grievance of the petitioner in the present writ petition is to the orders dated 08.09.2010 (Annexure P-6), 20.03.2007 (Annexure P-7), 04.11.2009 (Annexure P-9) & 08.09.2010 (Annexure P-10), whereby the objections of the petitioner have been dismissed.

It has been brought to the notice of this Court that the title suit has already been decided upto this Court vide order dated 18.02.2016 passed in **RSA Nos.4173, 3750 & 3751 of 2013** and **RSA No.2679 of 1994**.

The petitioner was the respondent in the partition application moved before the revenue court, thus, for all intents and purposes, their objections qua

maintainability of the application for partition had been dismissed upto this Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he is not in a position to apprise this Court about the final outcome of the partition proceedings as there was no interim stay.

Keeping in view the aforementioned facts, no cause of action survives in the present writ petition as partition proceedings must have been culminated into the final order.

No ground is made out for interference.

Dismissed.
