Prayer in this petition is for quashing of FIR No.73 dated 25.08.2013 under Sections 406, 420, 120-B, IPC registered at Police Station Nurmahal, District Jalandhar (Annexure P/1) along with all consequential criminal proceedings arising thereof.

Notice of motion in this case was issued on 7.3.2014 and a perusal of the subsequent interim order passed by this Court shows that at no point of time, there was any stay regarding proceedings before the trial court. On 31.8.2017, learned State counsel as well as complainant were directed to inform the stage of the trial.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Hans Raj has submitted that only petitioner Gurvinder Singh is facing trial and remaining 08 accused have been declared as proclaimed offender. It is submitted that the entire prosecution evidence has been concluded now. Thereafter, statement of the petitioner-accused under Section 313 Cr.P.C. has also been recorded and today, itself is the date before the trial court

for final arguments.

In view of the same, the prayer for quashing of the FIR at this stage is rendered as infructuous.

It will be open for the petitioner to raise all the plea/defence taken herein, before the trial court.
