INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioners-Nishan Singh and Surinder Singh have filed this 2nd petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for brevity, 'Cr.P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.183 dated 27.09.2017, registered at Police Station City-I, Abohar, District Fazilka, under Sections 223, 224 and 225 of the Indian Penal Code.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the prosecution version, two accused who were in custody even in a murder case, have been got released from the Court Complex with the help of the present petitioners.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and in view of nature and gravity of the offence, no ground is made out to grant the relief of anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
