RAMENDRA JAIN, J (ORAL)

The instant petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant regular bail to the petitioner-Udai Singh in case FIR No.221 dated 13.12.2015 under Sections 147, 148, 149, 323, 302, 452, 506, IPC, registered at Police Station Ateli, District Mohindergarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that no specific role has been attributed to the petitioner. The petitioner is alleged to have caused injuries with his Axe to the deceased Puran Singh, but according to the MLR and postmortem report, no injury alleged to have been found on the body of the deceased person caused by Axe. The petitioner is in custody since 23.02.2016. Co-accused having similar cases facts namely Ajay Singh, Pardeep Kumar and Kailash have already been granted regular bail.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the State assisted by Shri Aditya Sanghi, Advocate for the complainant has vehemently opposed the bail to the petitioner.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances of the case and considering the fact that co-accused Ajay Singh, Pardeep Kumar and Kailash have been granted regular bail, the petitioner-Udai Singh is also ordered to be released on regular bail, subject to his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
