The petitioner, Ennus Khan @ Mulla, seeks concession of anticipatory bail upon an FIR having been registered against him and his co-accused for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 323/325/506/34 IPC. As per the FIR, the petitioner as also one Mannu are stated to have picked up a brick from the road and hit it on the head and nose of the complainant, with another co-accused also having allegedly inflicted a brick injury on the left eye of the complainant. Thereafter, all the 4 accused are stated to have picked up a big stone and hit it on the head of the complainant. The complainant having been taken to the hospital by some other person, he was found to have injuries, including a fracture of the nasal bone, left orbit, left zygomatic arch, right thumb, head injury and other injuries as well.

Keeping in view the aforesaid, while making no comment on the merits of the case, the petitioner is not found entitled to the concession

of anticipatory bail.

Dismissed.
