INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner-Karnail Singh has filed this petition under Section 482 of Code of Criminal Procedure directing respondents No.2 to 4 not to harass the petitioner by calling in the police station time and again at the behest of respondents No.5 to 8.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that appropriate directions be issued to the official respondents to decide the representation dated 01.12.2017, submitted by the petitioner to Senior Superintendent of Police, Ropar and he does not press the other relief asked in the petition.

In view of above, Senior Superintendent of Police, Ropar-respondent No.2, is directed to decide the representation dated 01.02.2017, given by the petitioner only to the extent of harassment and pressure made by official respondents upon the petitioner on the behest of private

respondents, as per law within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, without being influenced by the order of this Court.

With aforesaid directions, disposed of.
