Learned State Counsel has placed on record status report by way of affidavit of Pankhuri Kumar, HPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Sector 29, Gurugram today in the Court, which is taken on record and on instructions received from ASI Manoj Kumar, Police Station Sector 29, Gurugram has made a statement before this Court to the effect that after reinvestigations the Police have concluded and taken the decision to file cancellation report as the allegations could not be substantiated.

In view of the statement of the learned State Counsel that police is likely to file cancellation report before the competent Court within 15 days from today, the learned counsel for the petitioner along with petitioner, who is present in person, has made a statement withdrawing the
