Learned counsel inter-alia contends that the petitioner is a transport contractor of the complainant and is not responsible for the misconduct and omission done by his driver. The petitioner has already joined the investigation pursuant to the order of the Additional Sessions Judge, Ludhiana, but finally his petition for anticipatory bail has been rejected illegally by the said Court. The petitioner is ready to rejoin the investigation.

Considering over all facts and circumstances, but without commenting anything on the merits of the case and seeing the seriousness of the allegations that theft of government milk is being committed regularly, no ground is made out to enlarge the petitioner on anticipatory bail. Hence, the petition is dismissed.
