In compliance of order dated 29.10.2013, passed by this Court,
additional affidavit on behalf of respondent Nos.1, 2 and 4 has been filed.
Same is taken on record.

As per the said affidavit, there were only 23 categories and not
25 (where there were contractual employees as well as regular employees)
and for all these 23 categories the wages being paid to the contractual
employees are at least equal to the minimum of the pay scale of the regular
employees, if not more.

In this view of the matter, the instant petition has been rendered
infructuous and is dismissed as such.
