Ritu Bahri, J.

By this common order, CRM-M-7522-2016 and CRM-M-33347-2016 shall be decided together as common question of law and facts are involved in both the petitions.

With the assistance of Mr. Naresh Gopal Sharma, Advocate/Mediator, parties have entered into a compromise. Compromise deed dated 20.03.2017, duly signed by both the parties, has been placed on record. As per compromise, Amit Monga-petitioner and Nisha Sharma-respondent No.1 have agreed to file a petition for divorce under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act before the Court of competent jurisdiction at

Rohtak. Petitioner has further agreed to pay a sum of Rs.50,00,000/-

(Rupees Fifty Lakh) to respondent No.1 as permanent alimony for past, present and future maintenance of respondent No.1 as well as both the minor children (respondent Nos. 2 and 3). Respondent No.1 has agreed to accept the said amount. As per terms of compromise, on the second motion of petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, respondent No.1 will withdraw her petition under Section 125 Cr.P.C. and under the Domestic Violence Act, which have been filed against the petitioner.

Since the matter has been amicably resolved between the parties, both the petitions i.e. CRM-M-7522 of 2016 and CRM-M-33347-2016 are disposed of in terms of the compromise/settlement deed dated 20.03.2017.
