Prayer in this petition is for quashing of FIR No. 224 dated 13.06.2001, under Sections 325, 323 and 34 I.P.C., registered at Police Station Sadar Batala, District Batala, on the basis of compromise.

The petition was filed through Special Power of Attorney of Ranbir Singh @ Romi, who is in France. The Special Power of Attorney is father of Ranbir Singh.

The petitioner was declared as proclaimed offender on 29.02.2008 and has not submitted himself to the jurisdiction of the Court.

Though the statements of the parties have been recorded before the Judicial Magistrate, Ist Class, Batala, but

this fact has come to fore that the petitioner was declared as proclaimed offender on 29.02.2008 and his co-accused, namely Satpal Singh @ Lali and Gurpal singh, have been acquitted by the Judicial Magistrate, Ist Class, Batala, vide judgment dated 01.11.2011.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner stated that the petitioner intends to appear before the trial Court and join the proceedings.

Keeping in view the attending facts and circumstances of the case and the fact that co-accused of the petitioner have since been acquitted by the trial Court, I allow the petitioner to appear before the trial Court within a period of one month.

In the event of appearance of the petitioner before the trial Court, he shall be granted regular bail by the said Court.
