Petitioner Randhir Singh (workman) had approached the Labour Court against his alleged illegal termination of service. The Labour Court vide award dated 11.11.2004 ordered reinstatement with continuity of service of workman and no orders were passed on back wages. This led Randhir Singh to file the present writ petition. Notice issued to the petitioner has come back unserved with the report that petitioner has since expired.

The fact that petitioner got the order of Labour Court for reinstatement with continuity of service and from the record we do not find that the Management has ever challenged that award, we assume that he must have been reinstated. Nobody is present on behalf of the petitioner. No legal representatives have been brought on record. In view of the aforesaid circumstances, we order that this writ petition be consigned to record-room with liberty to the parties/petitioner's legal representatives to get the case restored in accordance with law, if circumstances so exist.
