Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.325 dated 31.10.2014, registered at Police Station Rai, District Sonapat, under Sections 342, 395, 397 of Indian Penal Code and Section 25/54/59 of Arms Act.

Notice of motion was issued.

Learned State counsel appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the allegations, the petitioner along with co-accused forcibly took away 8 cows in a canter from the Gaushala by confining the workers.

The petitioner has been in custody since 10.03.2015 i.e. almost about two years. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation

purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long

time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
