The prayer in the instant petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.51 dated 14.05.2016 registered under Section 354, 376, 506, 511 IPC and Section 3 and 4 of POCSO Act, registered at Police Station Women Cell, District Patiala, whereas, learned trial Court under Section 319 Cr.P.C., summoned the petitioners to face trial for the offence punishable under Sections 4/17 of POCSO Act and Section 109 read with Section 354 IPC.

Pursuant to the order dated 15.02.2017, petitioners had appeared before the trial Court on 17.02.2017 and submitted their bail bonds which was accepted by the trial Court.
