The petitioners pray for quashing of FIR No.10 dated 14.2.2014 for offence under Sections 406, 498-A of the Indian Penal Code (in short "IPC") registered at Police Station, Badali Ala Singh, District Fatehgarh and proceedings emanating therefrom.

A report has been received from the trial court that charge was framed on 8.4.2015, seven witnesses of the prosecution have already been examined and the case was fixed for 6.4.2017 for remaining evidence of the prosecution.

Keeping in view the fact that trial has progressed to a substantial extent, I do not think it to be a fit case wherein intervention in exercise of jurisdiction under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure is warranted, in the circumstances.

Disposed of accordingly but without prejudice to rights of the petitioners to raise all available pleas before the trial court.
