Learned counsel for the petitioners fairly submitted that pursuant to the order dated 17.11.2016 petitioners have passed an order on 28.07.2017 while modifying the order of removal from service to that of censure. In view of these later development petition do not survive for further consideration.

Learned counsel for the respondent-workman submitted that petitioner is out of service from 01.09.2000 Therefore, he is entitled for back wages. It is made clear that respondent-workman is not entitled for full backwages and he is only entitled to 50% back wages from the date of the award passed by the Labour Court. The same shall be calculated by the petitioners and disbursed to the respondent-workman within a period of 3 months from today. If the same is not complied in that event respondent-

workman is entitled to interest @ 6% per annum. Further petitioners are hereby directed to take back the respondent-workman into service pursuant to the order dated 28.07.2017 within a period of 1 week from today.

With this observation, petition stands disposed of.
