Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in respect of the grievances of the petitioner, he has made a representation to the Superintendent of Police, Sirsa, on 17.12.2016, a copy of which has been annexed as Annexure P-7 with the petition, but no action has been taken by the police so far.

He submits that, at this stage, he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Superintendent of Police, Sirsa, i.e. respondent no.2, to take necessary action on the aforesaid representation, as is warranted as per law.

Consequently, without going into the merits of the case, in any manner whatsoever, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the Superintendent of Police, Sirsa, to look into the grievances of the petitioner and if the same are found to be genuine in any manner, to take necessary steps.

Learned counsel also submits that the petitioner is allegedly

being forced to keep his son and daughter-in-law with him and to accept their marriage, though he is not prepared to do so.

In the aforesaid circumstances, the SP, Sirsa, would go into the matter himself and ensure that neither party is unnecessarily harassed, including respondents no.5 and 6, and that the matter is amicably settled.
