Learned State counsel has informed this Court that husband of the petitioner has collected a sum of approximately Rs. five crore from different people and thereafter he has gone missing. However, the police has made every effort to trace him out but he is not traceable. Rather it is stated that he is wanted by the police as the police has received number of complaints and the police is going to register an FIR against him.

Let an FIR be registered against husband of the petitioner and he be traced as an accused. In case he is not traceable then appropriate proceedings under Cr.P.C. be initiated.

The present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
