This petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to fairly investigate and conclude the investigation of FIR No.147 dated 19.03.2015 registered under Sections 469, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code and Section 67-B of Information Technology Act and Section 13 (C) of Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 at Police Station Palam Vihar, District Gurgaon in a stipulated time frame.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2- Commissioner of Police, Gurgaon (Now Gurugram) to consider the present petition as representation and decide the same in a time bound manner.

At the asking of the Court, Ms. Dimple Jain, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. A complete copy of the

paper book has been furnished to the learned State counsel, in the Court.

In the circumstances, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, respondent No.2- Commissioner of Police, Gurgaon (Now Gurugram) is directed to consider the present petition as representation and take a final view in the matter as per law expeditiously preferably within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. The petitioner is also directed to furnish a copy of the petition to the Office of respondent No.2 along with the certified copy of this order.
