TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.(ORAL)

Petitioner seeks concession of pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.70 dated 21.10.2017, under Sections 307, 148, 149, 506 of Indian Penal Code along with Sections 25, 27 of Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Khem Karan, District Tarn Taran.

Counsel for the petitioner would vehemently argue that it is a case of no injury. Petitioner is sought to be falsely implicated only on account of he being the son of one Roop Singh co-accused and against whom the complainant had a previous dispute. Further contended that the petitioner had already associated with the investigation and in spite thereof the Court of learned Additional Sessions Judge, Tarn Taran has passed the impugned order dated 13.12.2017 declining anticipatory bail.

Counsel for the petitioner has been heard at length and

pleadings on record have been perused.

FIR has been registered at the instance of Balwinder Singh, complainant.

Allegations are pertaining to an incident of 19.10.2017. It has been alleged that the petitioner along with co-accused had attempted to make a forcible entry in the house of the complainant during the night hours. There are specific allegations against the petitioner of being armed with a rifle 315 bore and of having fired shots. The motive behind the alleged occurrence is also borne out from the FIR inasmuch as there was a money dispute between the complainant and the father of the petitioner.

There are specific and serious allegations against the petitioner.

It is a case which may well warrant custodial interrogation of the petitioner.

This Court as such does not find any infirmity in the order dated 13.12.2017 passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Tarn Taran declining the concession of pre-arrest bail.

Petition dismissed.
