The present application stands disposed off as the same has become infructuous.

CRM-M-4991 of 2017

The allegations in this anticipatory bail application under Section 438 Cr.P.C against the petitioners Kalpana Kaur and Jasmeet Kaur, mother and daughter respectively are that both of them in connivance with each other duped the complainant for sum of Rs.3 lacs on the assurance of securing job of Postman to the complainant.

The contentions of the learned counsel for the petitioners that the parties have effected a compromise and the complainant

side has been adequately compensated for their financial loss is admittedly acceded by learned counsel for the complainant, who submits that he does not objects the allowing of application.

In view of the compromise and orders dated 15.03.2017 placed on records passed in the petition moved by the parties for quashment on the basis of compromise, the present application is allowed. In the event of arrest of the petitioners they be admitted to bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer/Investigating Officer and that they shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
