This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C., seeking 'regular bail' to the petitioner, in case FIR No.92 dated 20.06.2016, registered for the alleged commission of the offences punishable under Sections 307, 148, 149 IPC, Section 25 of the Arms Act and Section 21 of the NDPS Act, at Police Station, Sadar, Phagwara, Tehsil Phagwara, Distt. Kapurthala.

In terms of the order dated 23.02.2017, an affidavit of Sh. Sandeep Kumar Sharma, Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala, has been filed in Court today by learned State counsel, stating therein that the vehicle in which the petitioner is stated to have been traveling, was a Toyota Qualis bearing No. PB08-AK-3666, which was earlier owned by one Pawan Kumar, but who had sold it to one Varinder Singh. As a matter of fact, as per the affidavit, it was taken on hire by one Gurpreet Singh @ Gopi from Varinder Singh.

The aforesaid apart, upon query, learned State counsel does not deny that the petitioner has been in custody for the past 10 months, with 04 out of 15 witnesses examined so far.

Considering the aforesaid facts, I deem it appropriate to admit the petitioner to bail.

Consequently, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, upon his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court.
