Petitioners allege threat to their life and liberty at the hands of respondent No.4 and who in turn is stated to be in connivance with respondents No.5 to 7. There are specific averments made in the petition as regards demand of illegal gratification at the hands of the police officials who have been impleaded as private respondents No.5 to 7. Further allegations are with regard to the petitioners having been beaten up mercilessly at Police Station Sector 11, Chandigarh.

Without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the instant petition with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh to look into the representation dated 18.12.2017 at Annexure P-2 which is stated to have already been submitted and thereafter to take steps as deemed fit and warranted in accordance with law.
