The petitioners claim themselves to be major. They have pleaded that they have married against the wishes of respondent Nos. 4 to 6 and seek protection to their lives and liberty. They apprehend danger at the hands of respondent Nos. 4 to 6. They have placed on record photographs (**Annexure P/3**) evidencing their marriage. The petitioners have also submitted a representation dated 22.12.2017 (**Annexure P/4**) to respondent No. 2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh to protect their lives and liberty.

Without entering upon an exercise to evaluate the evidentiary value of the documents placed on the file, I dispose of this petition with directions to respondent No. 2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh to decide the representation of the petitioners (**Annexure P/4**) within a period of

one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order and grant them protection, if any threat to their lives and liberty is perceived. It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to protect the petitioners from legal action for violation of law, if any committed by them.
