The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to respondents No. 1 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner as well as his family members at the hands of respondents No. 5 to 7 and investigate the matter on the representation dated 17.12.2017 (Annexure P-1).

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already approached respondent No. 3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga for redressal of his grievance, however, no action has been taken so far. He further submits that the petitioner would feel satisfied, at this stage, if a direction is issued to respondent No. 3 to decide the above said representation expeditiously.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. T. P. S. Chawla, DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State. Let adequate copies of the paper-book be supplied to him during the course of the day, failing which, no action is called for.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga to decide the representation dated 17.12.2017 by passing a speaking order within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
