This judgment shall dispose of both the aforementioned petitions.

In CRM-M-9984-2014 petitioner has prayed for quashing of order dated 01.03.2014 passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Rohtak (Annexure P-7) and order dated 04.02.2014 passed by JMIC, Rohtak (Annexure P-5), vide which, the application filed under Section 156 (3) Cr.P.C. by petitioner-Zile Singh was dismissed.

In CRM-M-9042-2017, petitioners have prayed for quashing the summoning order dated 25.11.2016 passed by JMIC, Rohtak (Annexure P-4) and the order dated 20.02.2017 passed by learned Sessions Judge,

Rohtak, dismissing the revision against the summoning order.

Parties are *ad idem* that since both the cases are version and cross version and arising out of the same incident. The same are being tried together before the trial Court. The counsel for both the parties have restricted arguments to the extent that a direction may be issued to the trial Court to decide both the cases on the same day.

Accordingly, the petitions are disposed of with a direction to the trial Court to dispose of both the version and cross version cases, out of which, these petitions have arisen, simultaneously, on the same day.
