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**ARVIND SINGH SANGWAN, J. (ORAL)**

This common order shall dispose of above noted two criminal petitions as they arise out of the same FIR.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in pursuance to order dated 28.03.2016 and 24.05.2016, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Bajleet Singh, submits that though the petitioners have joined the investigation, however, recovery of money is yet to be effected from them.

In reply, the learned counsel for the petitioners has referred to the reply of the legal notice issued by complainant-Aman Sharma through his counsel (Annexure P-4) where the factum of agreement to sell was admitted and it was also admitted that a total amount of Rs.40 lacs was paid as earnest money. It is further submitted on behalf of the petitioners that they have never misused the concession of interim bail.

Counsel for the petitioners further submits that petitioner-Gurpreet Singh has filed a suit on 24.04.2016 for suit declaration before the civil Court and the same is pending for adjudication.

In compliance of the order dated 28.03.2016, passed in CRM-M-8798 of 2016 and order dated 24.05.2016 passed by this Court in CRM-M-18209-2016, the petitioners have joined the investigation and have been granted concession of interim bail.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and in view of the facts that the petitioners have joined the investigation and are no more required for further investigation. The orders dated 28.03.2016 and 24.05.2016, granting interim bail to the petitioners, are made absolute.
