In the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., the petitioners seek directions to provide protection to their lives and liberty from the private respondents No.4 to 7, who are stated to be relatives of petitioner No.1.

It is pleaded that petitioners have got married on 26.12.2017 in Gurudwara Guru Nanak Niwas Sahib, village Karror Kalan, Tehsil Kharar, District Mohali. Marriage certificate is appended as Annexure P-3 and the photographs of the marriage have been appended as Annexure P-4. It is further submitted that the date of birth of petitioners are 06.01.1994 and 06.07.1990 respectively. In respect of age proof, photocopies of Aadhar Cards of both the petitioners are appended as Annexures P-1 and P-2 respectively.

A representation dated 26.12.2017 (Annexure P-5) for protection has been filed with respondent No.2 in this regard and resultantly this Court has been approached.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Suveer Sheokand, Addl. A.G.

Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the official

respondents-State.

After hearing counsel for the parties, without commenting upon the validity/legality of the marriage or the age of the petitioners and keeping in view the binding precedent of the Hon'ble Apex Court in **Lata Singh** v. **State of U.P. And another**; 2006 (2) SCC (Criminal) 478, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to look into the above said representation filed by the petitioners and take appropriate action in accordance with law and provide protection, if so required.
