ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking quashing of FIR No.401 dated 10.08.2015, under Sections 380/411 IPC, registered at Police Station Sector 34, Chandigarh (Annexure P-1), on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2) arrived at between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that FIR is the result of a misunderstanding between the parties and the matter has now been compromised.

This Court by the order dated 08.09.2017 had directed the parties to appear before the trial Court to record the statements of the parties with regard to genuineness of the compromise and send a report to this Court. The report of JMIC, Chandigarh, dated 20.09.2017 has been received, wherein it is stated that in pursuance to the order of this Court, the statements

of the parties were recorded which indicates that the compromise is genuine, without any coercion or undue influence.

The FIR is an outcome of a misunderstanding between the parties and the matter has now been compromised

In view of the mandate of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of ***Narinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another, (2014) 6 SCC 466***, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the petition is allowed and FIR No.401 dated 10.08.2015, under Sections 380/411 IPC, registered at Police Station Sector 34, Chandigarh (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioner(s).
