The present revision petition by Ramesh Chand is directed against the judgment of conviction and order of sentence dated 25.04.2012 passed by Special Judicial Magistrate, Kurukshetra, whereby he was convicted under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act (hereinafter referred to as, 'the Act') and was sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for six months and was directed to pay compensation of Rs.1,00,000/- with interest @ 12 % under Section 357(3) Cr.P.C. from the date of issuance of the cheque. Out of the said amount, an amount of Rs.2,000/- was directed to be deposited with the State as fine and in default of payment of the fine, the petitioner was directed to further undergo simple imprisonment for 15 days.

2. The petitioner preferred first appeal against the judgment of conviction and order of sentence dated 25.04.2012 before Additional Sessions Judge, Kurukshetra, but his appeal was dismissed by first appellate

Court vide judgment dated 04.10.2013. Feeling aggrieved, the petitioner has

filed the instant revision petition.

3. Today, the matter was taken up in the National Lok Adalat and the parties have arrived at an amicable settlement. Gurdev Singh, Manager, The Hind Cooperative NATC Society, in his statement has stated as under:-

“The society has settled the matter with the petitioner and nothing is due against the petitioner. The society has no objection if the present petition is allowed.”

In view of the above, this petition stands allowed and the judgment of conviction and order of sentence dated 25.04.2012 passed by Special Judicial Magistrate, Kurukshetra and the judgment dated 04.10.2013 of Additional Sessions Judge, Kurukshetra are set aside.
