This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.77 dated 29.06.2016, under Sections 306/34 IPC, registered at Police Station, Khamanon, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

The petitioner is in custody since 29.06.2016.

Marriage of the petitioner was solemnized with Sandeep Kaur (younger sister of complainant) in the year 2006. Out of this wedlock, two children namely Amrinder Singh and Simranjit Kaur were born on 21.03.2007 and 12.11.2010 respectively. Later on, Sandeep Kaur, wife of petitioner, committed suicide.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, has informed the Court that after presentation of challan, charges have already been framed against the accused-petitioner and there are 13 prosecution witnesses, who have to

be examined. Two minor children are staying in the house of petitioner.

Heard.

Keeping in view the period of incarceration of the petitioner and the fact that trial may take some time for its conclusion, this Court feels that there is no need to detain the petitioner any longer. Accordingly, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be enlarged on regular bail on furnishing of bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate/Chief Judicial Magistrate, Fatehgarh Sahib.
