Heard, records perused as is reflected from the record of the trial Court that challan was presented on 09.12.2010 and on account of various reasons the proceedings were put to hold and CM No.3521 was filed before the trial Court praying that the proceedings be stayed and subsequently vide order dated 08.08.2012 the same was dismissed. In spite of the same nothing has been done since the framing of the charges on 13.10.2012 in spite of more than 46 opportunities of adjournment having been granted. Thus apparently not much has proceeded in the trial, impels this Court to dispose of the present petition by issuing directions to the trial Court to expedite the trial and ensure that no date more than a period of fifteen days is granted in any case and ensure that the trial is disposed off preferably within a period of two months with effect from the date of receipt of this order.
