Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that no other case has been registered against the petitioner and that in the present case, she has been falsely roped in.

Having considered the aforesaid argument, since the earlier petition filed by the petitioner (CRM No.M-38714 of 2016) has already been dismissed by a coordinate Bench on 21.11.2016 and no change of circumstance is shown, whatsoever, granting anticipatory bail to her would amount to sitting on the judgment of a coordinate Bench.

Learned counsel submits that he may be allowed to withdraw this petition with liberty to file an application seeking regular bail before the learned trial Court.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty. The learned trial Court would decide the bail application of the petitioner, if any such application is moved, on merits, within a period of one week of its filing.
