On 16.02.2017, following order was passed by this
Court:-

*“Learned counsel for the petitioner
contends that even if qualification of MA Political
Science is to be ignored, the petitioner was
possessing the requisite qualification in terms of
his post graduation qualification of M.Ed with
60%.*

Notice of motion for 03.04.2017.

*In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed
to appear before the SHO/Investigating Officer to
join investigation on 22.02.2017 and in the event*

of his arrest, he shall be enlarged on ad interim bail, subject to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, petitioner shall abide by the conditions incorporated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that in pursuance of aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

This fact has not been disputed by learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Ranbir Singh and further submitted that he is no more required in further investigation of the case.

In view of above, order dated 16.02.2017 is hereby made absolute. However, petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when called upon to do so.
