Rekha Mittal, J.

The sole grievance of the petitioner is that the revisional court while adjourning the case to 9.3.2017 has directed the petitioner to clear all the dues and the liability in this manner comes to approximately Rs. 09 lakhs. It is further submitted that the trial court has awarded interim maintenance @ Rs. 30,000/- per month and a sum of Rs. 10,000/- per month towards rent from the date of filing of the application till disposal of the case. Another submission made by counsel is that the order passed by the trial court has led to filing of two separate petitions one by the petitioner-husband and other by the respondent-wife and the same are pending before the court below for 9.3.2017.

Without examining rival claims of the parties, the present petition stands disposed of with the observations that the petitioner shall clear arrears of maintenance as well as rental to the extent of 50% by the

next date of hearing fixed by the revisional court. The revisional court shall put its best efforts to dispose of the revisions expeditiously.

Before parting with the order, it is clarified that the petition has been disposed of without notice to the respondent in order to avoid inconvenience and incurring expenditure by her. However, if the respondent has any grievance to express, she shall be at liberty to file an appropriate application before this Court.
