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Petitioner-Vipin Arora has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.156 dated 08.07.2016, registered at Police Station Kotwali, District Bathinda, under Section 420 IPC and Section 120-B IPC added later on.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared on behalf of respondent-State and contested this petition.

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I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the prosecution version, the complainant was cheated to the tune of ₹6,93,000/- as the petitioner alongwith co-accused took away his currency notes by impersonating as bank employee.

The petitioner has been in custody since 05.11.2016. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case. Moreover, the offences are triable by the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with two sureties in the like amount each to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
