The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.210 dated 15.12.2016 registered under Sections 323, 325, 452, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Sadar, District Ludhiana.

A coordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 17.02.2017 had passed the following order:-

“Notice of motion for 06.04.2017.

In the event of arrest of the petitioner in FIR No. 210, dated 15.12.2016, registered under Sections 323, 325, 452, 148 and 149 IPC, at Police Station Sadar Ludhiana, District Ludhiana, the petitioner shall be admitted to ad-interim anticipatory bail subject to the satisfaction of the arresting officer.

The above concession, however, is subject to the conditions prescribed in Section 438(2) Cr. P. C.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from HC Balwinder Singh states that the petitioner has joined investigation and the recovery has also

been effected from him and therefore, he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the order dated 17.02.2017 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.
