This petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0145 dated 16.10.2016, under Section 498-A IPC, registered at Police Station, Sadar, Sangrur, District Sangrur.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Bant Singh, has informed that in compliance with the order dated 12.01.2017, information has been collected from the neighbours of Neetu Kumar-petitioner and they have stated that he has solemnized marriage with Sarbo. However, this lady (Sarbo) was not found in her own house.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he has no instructions to appear in this case now. The petitioner has not even paid the litigation expenses as directed by this Court.

In view of the said fact, the petitioner does not deserve the concession of anticipatory bail.

Dismissed.
