Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been made for quashing of F.I.R. No.82 dated 27.10.2013 under Sections 186, 353, 332, 427, 506 of the Indian Penal Code pertaining to Police Station Kabarwala, District Muktsar Sahib, on the basis of compromise Annexure-P2.

In compliance of the order dated 08.05.2017 of this Court, the parties appeared before the trial Court on 23.05.2017 to get recorded their statements. Learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Malout has also sent its report vide covering letter No.295 dated 31.05.2017 which has been duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Sri Muktsar Sahib vide letter No.1637/EB dated 01.06.2017.

According to the report, the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Malout is satisfied that the parties have made an amicable settlement voluntarily and have recorded their statements in the Court without any undue influence, pressure and coercion from any side.

Considering the report of Judicial Magistrate dated 31.05.2017 and the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, F.I.R. No.82 dated 27.10.2013 under Sections 186, 353, 332, 427, 506 I.P.C. pertaining to Police Station Kabarwala, District Muktsar Sahib, is hereby quashed.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
