Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the other co-accused of the petitioner has been acquitted of the charges framed against him and the petitioner is identically placed. However, the petitioner during the course of the trial, absented himself and was eventually declared to be a proclaimed person after having been on bail earlier.

Having considered the aforesaid arguments, since the issue herein is not with regard to the charges framed against the petitioner in the main trial but on him absenting himself and not answering the summons of the trial Court, this petition is dismissed. However, upon the petitioner surrendering before the trial Court, in the aforesaid circumstances that Court would decide the bail application, if any, is moved by the petitioner, on the same day.
