Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 08 dated 19.01.2017 registered under Sections 406/498A IPC at Police Station City Sunam, District Sangrur.

It is submitted that during the pendency of this petition, the matter has been amicably resolved between the parties. The petitioner and his wife have decided to part ways. A petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 has been filed by them. The petitioner has joined investigation in this case. It is, thus, prayed that this petition be allowed.

Learned counsel for the complainant affirms that the matter has been amicably resolved between the parties.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Mithu Ram, submits that the petitioner has joined investigation. His custodial interrogation is not required.

There are no allegations on behalf of the State that the petitioner is likely to abscond, if released on bail.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances noted above specifically the settlement between the parties but without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, it is considered just and expedient to allow this petition. Consequently, order dated 17.02.2017 is made absolute.
