This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.879 dated 21.10.2016 registered under Section 304-A IPC PS Camp Palwal, District Palwal.

Pursuant to the previous orders, FSL report has been produced in the Court today. The same is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody since 25.10.2016 and nothing is to be recovered from him. He further submits that all the material witnesses have been examined and that as per FSL report no common poison is detected.

Mr. Surender Singh, learned Law Officer representing the State, on instructions from ASI Dharambir, admits that all the material witnesses have been examined, but opposes the bail.

On giving a careful thought to submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and learned State counsel, I see no reason why the regular bail should not be granted to the petitioner. Accordingly, while allowing the instant petition, petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of concerned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.
