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DEEPAK SIBAL, J.(ORAL)

Through the present petition, quashing of FIR No.61, dated 10.04.2014, under Sections 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 IPC, registered at Police Station Civil Lines Bathinda (Annexure P-1), is sought for on the basis of compromise(Annexure P-2).

Through order of this Court dated 15.11.2016, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court to get their statements recorded, who in turn was directed to send a report to this Court.

As directed, report dated 28.11.2016 from the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Bathinda, has been received, as per which the parties recorded their statements before the trial Court in terms of the compromise arrived at between them.

In view of the above, continuation of the proceedings in pursuance of the afore-referred FIR would be an abuse of the process of law

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and in terms of the law laid down by the Full Bench of this Court in
Kulwinder Singh and others versus State of Haryana and others, 2007

(3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, I deem it just and proper to allow the petition
and resultantly quash the FIR No. 61, dated 10.04.2014, under Sections 419,
420, 465, 467, 468, 471 IPC, registered at Police Station Civil Lines
Bathinda(Annexure P-1), and all proceedings arising therefrom.
