ARVIND SINGH SANGWAN, J (ORAL)

This is a petition under Section 482 Cr. P.C. for quashing of the FIR No. 212 dated 10.10.2007 under Sections 323, 506, 148, 149 and 325 IPC (added later on), registered at Police Station Mahilpur, District Hoshiarpur (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 27.1.2017 (Annexure P-2).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance to order dated 20.2.2017, parties were directed to appear before the trial Court to get their statements recorded. Trial Court, vide its report dated 10.5.2017 has submitted that other four accused of the petitioner have been acquitted on 22.3.2016 and petitioner has now effected a compromise with the complainant-respondent No. 2. It is also reported that both parties have made a statement accepting and acknowledging the compromise. As per report, petitioner was declared proclaimed offender vide order dated 7.2.2015. The said order has already been set aside, subject to payment of ₹ 15,000 as costs, in another connected CRM-M-3842-2017, filed by the present petitioner, vide a separate order passed today i.e.

In view of above, present application is allowed and FIR No. 212 dated 10.10.2007 under Sections 323, 506, 148, 149 and 325 IPC (added later on), registered at Police Station Mahilpur, District Hoshiarpur and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua the petitioner.

Disposed of as above.
