Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.464 dated 29.12.2006, registered under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC at Police Station Samalkha, District Panipat.

Petitioner along with co-accused Sukhdev Singh are alleged to have impersonated Rajpal Singh and Balbir Singh co-sharers and received Rs.1 crore by way of inducement to the complainant to invest in the property. An agreement was also executed in favour of the complainant Raj Singh containing alleged thumb impressions of Rajpal Singh and Balbir Singh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner stated that co-accused Sukhdev Singh against whom similar allegations were

made has since been granted regular bail on 24.09.2016 by this Court in CRM-M No.29248 of 2016.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Rajpal, admitted the aforesaid position.

The petitioner was declared a proclaimed offender and was arrested on 22.01.2016 and since then he is in custody. The challan has already been presented and the case of the petitioner is not distinguishable from that of Sukhdev Singh, who has been granted bail by this Court on 24.09.2016.

At this stage, without advertng to the merits of the case, I am of the view that petitioner, who is in custody since 22.01.2016 can be enlarged on bail.

In view of above, petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be enlarged on bail, subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Nothing expressed hereinabove would be construed to be an expression of any opinion on merits of the case.
