Petitioner Sandeep Singh has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.364, dated 14.12.2016, registered at Police Station Sector 39, Chandigarh under Sections, 336, 307 and 34 of Indian Penal Code and 25 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Notice of motion.

Mr. G.S. Chahal, Addl. Public Prosecutor, U.T. Chandigarh has put in appearance on behalf of respondent-U.T. Chandigarh and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned Addl. Public Prosecutor for U.T. Chandigarh and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the prosecution version, the accused fired 2-3 shots from the pistol, but it is a no injury case.

The petitioner has been in custody since 17.12.2016. He is not

required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹40,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
