By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in FIR No.145 dated 27.10.2016, registered under Sections 420 and 120-B of IPC, at Police Station Meharban, Ludhiana.

It is contended that in pursuance of the order dated 20.02.2017, the petitioner has joined the investigation. Co-accused Pawan Kumar who is mediator has already been admitted to bail by this Court, vide order dated 23.01.2017. The petitioner is not the beneficiary. The petitioner has been falsely implicated being the sister in-law of main accused Sona who is in custody.

The learned State counsel, on instructions submits that the though petitioner has joined the investigation, however, she is

signatory to the agreement.

Considering the fact that the petitioner has repeatedly joined the investigation, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 20.02.2017, is made absolute, subject to furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

The petition stands allowed.
