In response to notice issued, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Raj Kumar who is present in Court today to assist him, submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and at present his custodial interrogation is not required.

Learned counsel for the complainant submits that the petitioner has, as a matter of fact, produced a false certificate and therefore, he does not deserve the concession of anticipatory bail.

Having considered the aforesaid arguments, in view of the fact that the documents alleged to have been forged are already in the possession of the investigating agency, which therefore does not require the custodial interrogation of the petitioner, the interim order dated 17.02.2017 is made

absolute on the same terms and conditions.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
