The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. Seeking concession of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in FIR No.566 dated 16.11.2016, under Sections 323, 427, 506, and 452 IPC and Section 8 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, registered at Police Station City, Narnaul, District Mahendergarh.

Counsel for the parties have been heard.

As per the prosecution version, FIR came to be registered on the complaint of Puran Chand. Allegations pertains to an incident that took place in the night of 15.09.2016 wherein the present petitioner under the influence of liquor attempted an act of sodomy on the grandson of the complainant.

During the course of hearing, police file has been perused. Statement of the victim has been recorded under Section 164 Cr.P.C. and which prima facie corroborates the version of the complainant.

Against the seriousness of the charge and gravity of the offence, this Court does not find any infirmity in the order dated 02.02.2017 passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Narnaul declining the concession of anticipatory bail.

Petition is dismissed.
