The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No.9 dated 01.07.2016, for the offence under Sections 406, 498-A IPC registered at Police Station Women Cell, Jagraon, Distt. Ludhiana (Annexure P-1) along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).

The marriage of the complainant was solemnized with the son of the petitioners i.e. Sarwan Kumar-petitioner No.3 on 12.07.2017 at Mubarak Palace, Raikot Road, Mullanpur, Ludhiana. The FIR was registered with the allegations of demand of dowry (Annexure P-1). During the pendency of trial, the connected petition i.e. CRM-M-26249 of 2016 seeking anticipatory bail of the petitioners was referred to Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court and the matter was finally compromised on 17.01.2017 which was

petitioner shall pay Rs.12.5 Lacs to the complainant/respondent No.2 as full and final permanent alimony.

On notice, complainant/respondent No.2 has put in appearance in Court today. Counsel for the petitioner has handed over two drafts of Rs.3,00,000/- each (total Six Lacs) to the respondent No.2/complainant in terms of compromise. As per terms of the compromise, Rs.9 Lacs has been paid to the complainant and only Rs.3.5 Lacs is required to be paid to complainant by the petitioner on 31.08.2017 i.e. the date which is fixed for statement of both the parties under Section 13-B of HMA.

Complainant-Satnam Kaur has filed her affidavit stating therein that Rs.3 lacs was paid to her at the time of filing of petition under Section 13-B of HMA and today petitioner has paid her Rs.6 lacs by way of two demand drafts of Rs.3,00,000/- each. The affidavit of complainant/respondent No.2 is taken on record.

Accordingly, FIR No.9 dated 01.07.2016, for the offence under Sections 406, 498-A IPC registered at Police Station Women Cell, Jagraon, Distt. Ludhiana (Annexure P-1) is quashed along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom qua the petitioners.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
